







2.1 Do you think the TEAL2.O project can contribute to improving the quality and accessibility of open and online education in the areas of Science, Engineering and Technology?












2.4 Do you feel you have enough information about the planned functionalities of the TEAL2.0 platform?

2.6 Would you and your organization be interested in testing or using the TEAL2.0 platform once it is developed?












2.7 Do you feel you will need training in order to use the TEAL2.0 platform?

3.2 Were the discussions during the workshop fruitful?


